THE SECTOR

The construction sector contributes **6%** to GDP, with **21,000** micro, small and medium employers generating growth in local communities across Scotland.

Employing over **231,000** people, the industry is key to the Scottish Government's plans for economic transformation over the next ten years.

The industry needs an **extra 19,550 workers** from 2023 to 2027.

APPRENTICESHIPS

Of the 30,000 apprentices learning in Scotland, **almost a third** are in construction.

We will help recruit **1,500** new apprentices in Scotland in 2023-24 and support these apprentices with **£10m** CITB and Skills Development Scotland investment.

We also provide £12.7 million to employers in apprenticeship grants.

EMPLOYER SUPPORT

Our Skills and Training Fund provides up to £10,000 for small businesses and up to £25,000 for medium-sized firms to support leadership, management, and development training.

Our Industry Impact Fund can provide up to £500,000 per proposal to improve productivity, equality, diversity, and inclusion in the sector.

We have created short courses in leadership and management, and will provide **10,500 free** ILM leadership and management courses to front-line managers, site supervisors, and site managers.

We have **two** pilot employer networks designed to simplify the way employers in Scotland access the training and support they need.

We offer over **140 courses** at our National Construction College in Inchinnan.

18,700 individuals and employers accessed CITB training support in 2022.
